Registering for and attending events at William & Mary conveys a shared expectation of abiding by university policy, which is subject to change as conditions warrant. As of September 7, 2021, those requirements include masking indoors as well as outdoors when unable to maintain social distancing except when actively eating or drinking. Vaccination is required of all William & Mary students, faculty

and staff, and it is strongly encouraged for all external visitors in alignment with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidance. We create these shared expectations of event participants in keeping with William & Mary's core values of *Belonging* within this community and *Respect* for one another as individuals, and in recognition of the risks inherent to gathering amid pandemic.

### Parking

Visitor passes are not required during Family Weekend. From Friday through Sunday, you may park in any regular Faculty/Staff, Day Student or Resident Student space on campus, unless otherwise indicated. Handicapped spaces are available throughout campus for those with an official handicapped license plate or hangtag. Use the interactive Campus Map ([www.wm.edu/campusmap](http://www.wm.edu/campusmap)) for parking locations.

Parking meters are enforced at all times, unless the meter specifies otherwise.

### Çudamani: Gamelan Music and Dance of Bali, Indonesia

*Williamsburg Regional Library Theater, 515 Scotland St.*

Internationally hailed as one of Bali's most forward-thinking music and dance ensembles, Çudamani is known for their exceptional creativity and superb artistry and also their unflagging love for the classical treasures of Balinese tradition. Nurtured and trained in the village of Pengosekan, the group is among Bali's most respected and accomplished. One of their many singular features is that many of their artists are multi-disciplinary, mastering gamelan, dance, voice, and visual art resulting in artistically unified presentations.

The 21-member ensemble and musicians and dancers weaves layers of intricate sound: the punctuation of deep great bronze gongs; charismatic leadership from the drums; stunning interlocking percussion from the bronze gangsa; and finely elaborated delicacy of voice and flute. Known for dance, the company includes virtuosic soloists as well as ensemble work where all company members dance.

Çudamani's residency is part of the Asian Centennial at William & Mary and is made possible with the generous support of the Arts & Sciences Annual Fund, Asian and Middle Eastern Studies, Global Studies, The Reves Center for International Studies, the Office for Student Diversity, the Center for Liberal Arts, Colonial Williamsburg, and the Williamsburg Regional Library Theater.

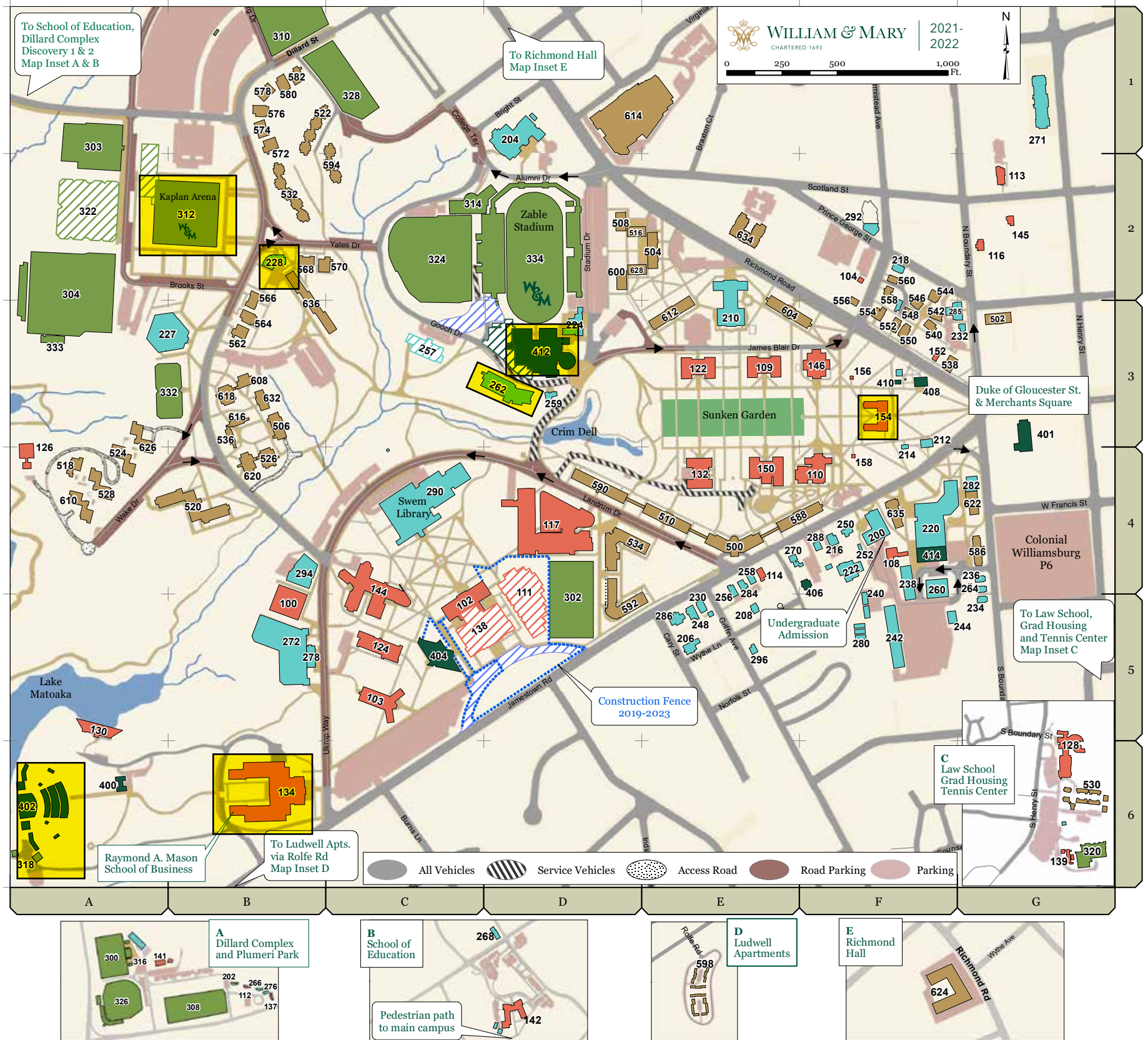
