### **University of Adelaide Exchange/Direct Enroll**

The tuition exchange agreement between the College of William & Mary and the University of Adelaide allows W&M students to pay their regular tuition to W&M while taking classes at Adelaide. The exchange program is best for VA in-state students. Students not chosen for the exchange program have the option of direct enrolling. Estimated costs for direct enrollment are: AUD\$9,800 (USD\$8,500) for one semester and AUD\$19,600 (USD\$16,930) for two semesters.
