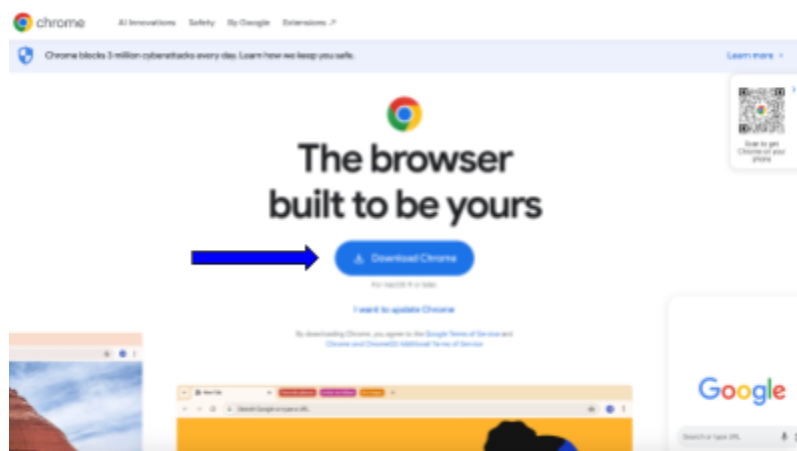
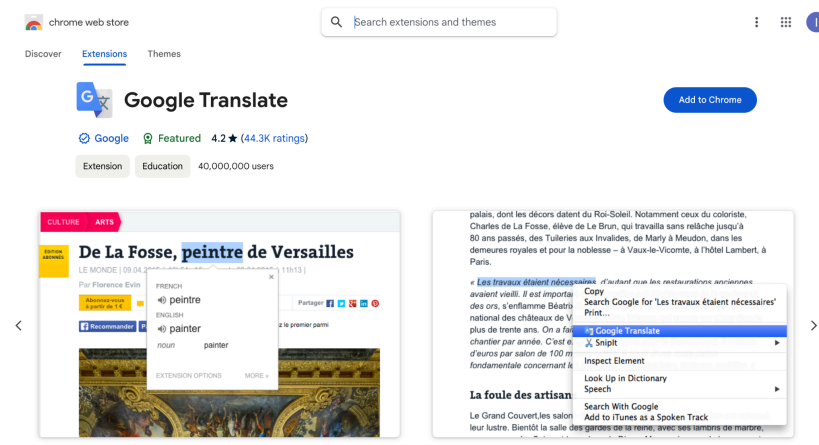


How to add Google Translate Extension

- Step 1) Start by downloading Google Chrome: <https://www.google.com/chrome/>



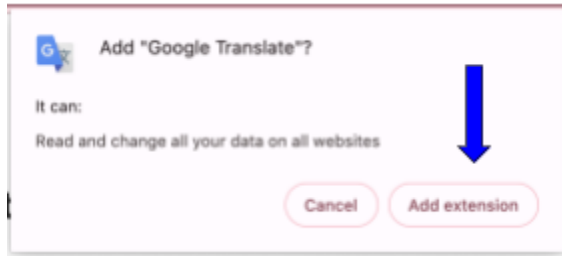

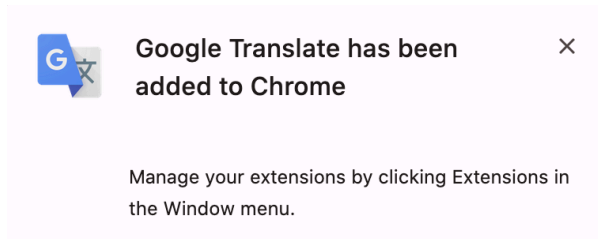
- Step 3) Click add to Chrome



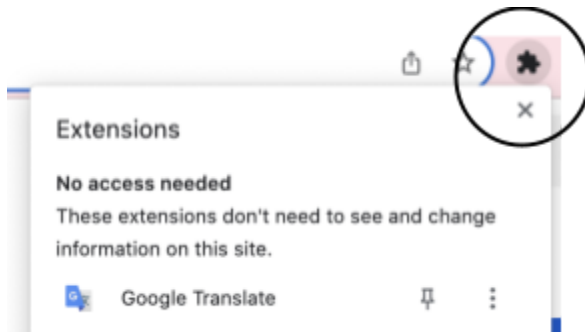
- Step 4) Click "add extension"



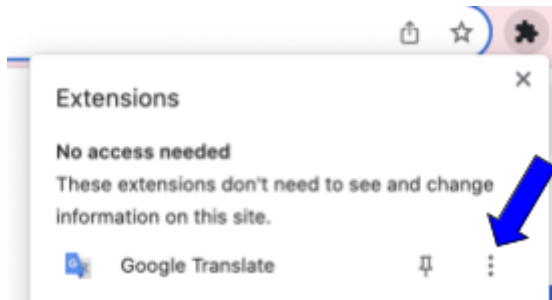

- Step 5) This confirmation should pop up on your screen



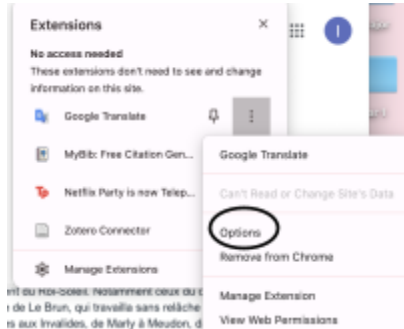

- Step 8) Click on the three dots on the side of "google translate"



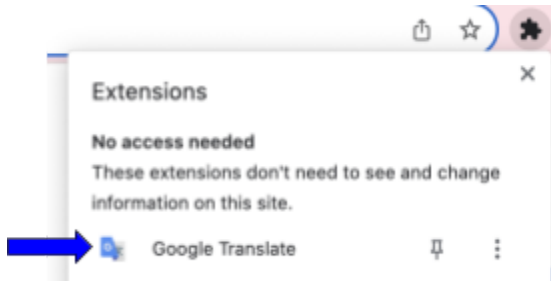

- Step 9) click on "options"



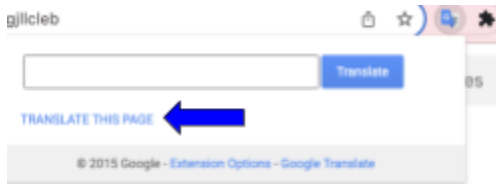
