BUAD 422: Concerns, echoing CLA, that this seems more like a C350 than a C300. Rejected.

CLCV 401: Concern voiced that the proposal lacked specifics to evaluate. No syllabus for the course. Also, course is currently described as a lecture, but this seems inaccurate. Tabled for more detail on assignments, delinking. To be recoded as Independent Study.

EDUC 426: CLA raised concern that it doesn't sufficiently address race. Tabled for more details, with suggestion that learning objectives address race. Proposal also says course carries a 400 attribute; a typo?
