CLCV name change request – Put on hold

- Ben will be meeting with CLCV to discuss whether this is a simple name change or a more involved change in the degree name at SCHEV.
- There is much more involved in changing the degree than just the name.
- Also noted that programs and concentrations are not under the umbrella of items that SCHEV oversees – for example for changes in the name for Russian/Russia and Eastern European studies does not change the degree from a BA in International Studies

MUSC E26/AFST/LAS - Brazilian Music Ensemble - Approved

- May need a different number than E26 in order to cross-list, will be worked out at the registrar's level.
- Concerns over courses with attendance as the primary grade
- Seems to be the norm for some music/ensemble courses.
- Deference given to faculty/programs in these types of courses regarding grading for this type of course.

Discussion:

- There were still questions about the results of additional conversations with departments and responses to questions about implementation.
- Concerns expressed about timing and getting proposal to FAS and BOV before next year.

- EPC's primary concern is to address the curriculum and not implementation.
- Marine Science still needs to meet with Math and Chemistry planned for later in the week.
- While EPC is reviewing the curriculum there is a question regarding EPCs role in approving an undergraduate degree curriculum for a school outside of A&S and additional questions regarding the necessity of FAS to approve the degree program. This may only be an agreement between the Dean of A&S and the School of Marine Science, in that A&S agrees to provide some of the curricular support (prerequisites and some electives) for a degree that is primarily housed in a different school.
- These are issues that may come up as degree programs currently under A&S move to the "new school".
- Due to questions about the role of EPC, an informal vote was held with general approval and two abstentions.

Michael will convey the results of the vote/discussion to Marine Science.

Ben will convey the results of the vote/discussion to the Dean of A&S.
