

MERIDIAN SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

Our first suggestion is to pack lightly – you don't need to haul everything from your dorm room to DC... although there is plenty of room in your apartments for everything you'd like! Other than a laptop, consider leaving your valuables at home. Here's a suggested packing list to get you started:

FOR YOUR ROOM Soft/collapsible luggage you can fit under your bed Desk storage Laundry basket / detergent Laundry rack to hang clothes Extra hangers Shoe rack Full-length mirror Additional storage drawers	FOR YOUR KITCHEN (already equipped with basics – see "What is already in 450K for me?" for more info) • Specialty items (Foreman, crockpot, rice cooker) • Brita/water filter or pitcher • Cleaning Supplies (dishwasher detergent, etc.) • Toilet Paper/Paper towels • Trash bags
FOR YOUR BATHROOM Toiletries Toilet paper Plunger	 FOR YOUR CLASSES Personal Printer (there is one computer/printer in the 450K media center, and you will have access to printers at the Washington Center) Notebooks, pens, etc. Required books (check with your professor)
FOR YOURSELF Any prescription medications Casual/workout clothes Comfortable walking shoes Camera Sunglasses Umbrella W&M Student ID Driver's License Health Insurance Card Portable speakers First Aid Supplies (Advil, Band-Aids)	 FOR YOUR JOB Two nice suits for internship and/or special events Coordinated clothing that works with your workplace dress code (generally business casual) Weather appropriate clothes Briefcase or big purse for work Day planner Appropriate shoes (to wear at work, and for walking to the office) Passport/SS Card (check with your internship what is required)
