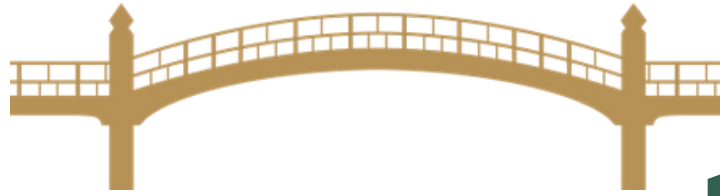

Did You Know?

Phishing is when attackers attempt to trick users into clicking a bad link resulting in a malware download or directing them to an unsecure website.

Some Signs of Phishing:

- Unfamiliar greeting
- Grammar errors & misspelled words
- Emails and domain names that do not match
- Unusual request-often a request for login credentials
- Urgency

If you suspect a phishing attempt always report at Abuse@wm.edu

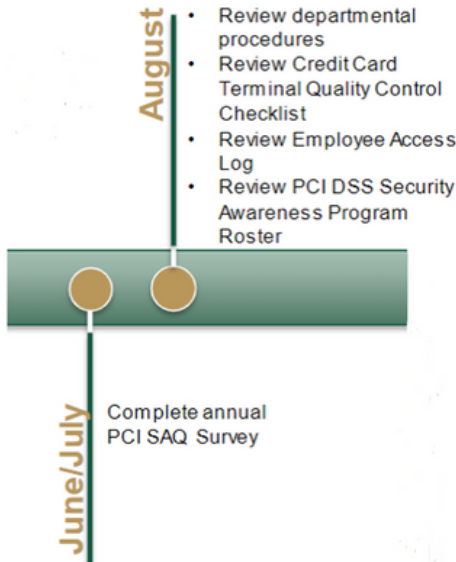
