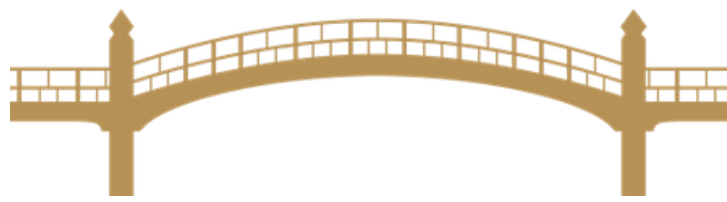

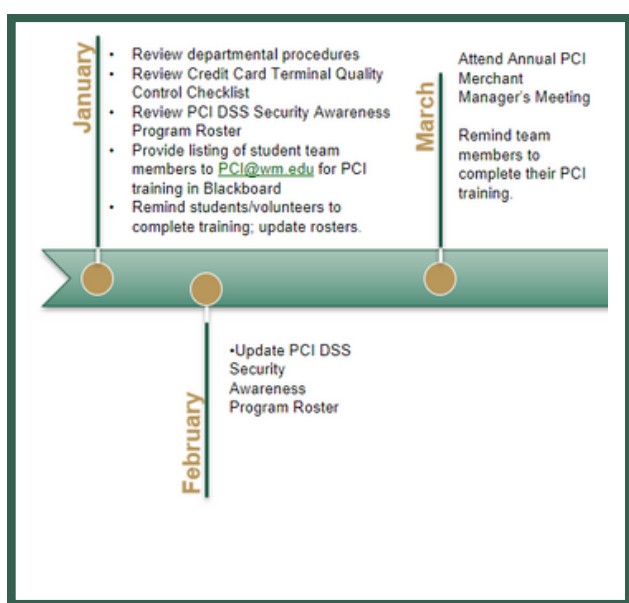
Good Things Are Happening at Osher!

The Osher Institute at William & Mary – our lifelong learning program for adults 50 “and better” – is growing in impact and reach. Established in 1991 as the Christopher Wren Association, the non-credit educational program was designated as one of 125 Osher Institutes across the U.S. in 2018. Rebuilding post-pandemic, the group has grown to 1,250 members and a 150-strong volunteer faculty, revived its presence with classes – now held on the Old Campus, and has brought a vibrant community of lifelong learners to W&M. With classes presented by 100+ volunteer instructors, Spring 2024 is gearing up now with 119 courses in 15 subject areas ranging from arts and the humanities to STEM, history, and Williamsburg life & lore.
