\* **Parlor Fee:** Fee to account for members using the chapter house who don't pay to live there.

#### **Payment Plan Options:**

Initiated member dues are due on August 6 prior to the fall semester. New member dues are due by Initiation, which typically happens in mid-November.

#### Extraordinary Membership Status (EMS)

An initiated member may apply for EMS if they have an extraordinary circumstance preventing them from participating in any chapter activities. EMS is an option for reduced dues. New members can apply for EMS at the beginning of their second semester. This is granted to up to 2 members and must be applied for.

#### Payment Plans

If a member wishes, they can be on a payment plan, paying their dues at three separate times throughout the semester, one third at a time. These three dates are pre-set: 08/06/2024, 09/10/2024, 10/15/2024

#### Installment Plans

If a member wishes, they can be on an installment plan. This is a custom payment plan, which is set up with the Finance Committee to better fit a member's financial needs. The dues can be paid in custom amounts on custom dates, if approved by the chapter.

# Scholarship opportunities:

Delta Delta Headquarters provides scholarships that can be applied for by March 1 for the upcoming year. They are a mixture of need based and merit-based scholarships, with one local Virginia scholarship.

# Sorority residency requirements:

*All 15 spots in the chapter house must be filled* on a volunteer, then systematic lottery system basis. Volunteer priority is given in order of graduating class and officer position status. If spots are not filled, people will be pulled to live in the house starting with Sophomores.

All Sorority Housing is owned and operated by the University Housing Office. Items included in the perterm range amounts are: Room, deposit, wireless internet, air conditioning.

2024-2025 campus housing costs, as set by the University Housing office, are as follows: Campus housing, including room and board per term: Single \$5,634.00, Double \$5,222.50

# Other chapter associated costs:

Clue Week occurs at the beginning of the semester and members taking a little may spend between \$50 and \$100. As a second semester freshman, Pansy Week (a week to celebrate seniors) occurs where freshman make baskets for their assigned senior which typically is about \$50. This is required but the amount one spends is up to the member. Apparel for non-philanthropic events is not covered by the chapter, members may spend around \$60 per semester. This is an optional expenditure, and not expected of members.

The fine for a late payment is 2% of dues per billing cycle, which is 30 days. (This is the only fine the chapter or national headquarters imposes).
