**Please describe your payment plans, if provided:**

Gamma Phi Beta provides two opportunities to help members who need financial support. If a member wishes, they may pay their dues in three separate installments throughout the semester, as opposed to once at the beginning of the semester. These will be due the 1st of October, November, and December in the Fall and the 1st of March, April, and May in the Spring. There is no limit on the number of members on a payment plan. This status provides an option for reduced dues if an Initiated Member is experiencing financial hardship, inability to attend chapter meetings/activities, or a combination of the two. Initiated Members must follow international procedure and apply to be placed on Excused Status, which is valid for one semester. The procedure includes providing a written statement to the executive council and receiving approval from the Financial Advisor and Chapter Advisor. No more than 3 Initiated Members may be placed on Excused Status in a given semester. All New and Initiated Members may disclose their preference for a Payment Plan, while Excused Status is reserved only for Initiated Members.

**Please describe scholarship options for new and current members, if provided:**

The Gamma Phi Beta Foundation provides need and merit-based scholarships that a member may apply for at [www.gammaphibeta.org/FinancialAid](http://www.gammaphibeta.org/FinancialAid). Applications for the 2025-2026 school year will open in late fall of 2024.

**Sorority residency requirements:**

*All 17 spots must be filled.* All members are required to sign an agreement committing to living in the house if a vacancy arises that cannot be filled. If spots remain open after volunteers are requested, eligible members agree to be pulled via a random lottery process. Seniors, members who are bound by lease agreements at the time of the vacancy, and members whose housing accommodations cannot be adequately met are considered ineligible. All Sorority Housing is owned and operated by the University Housing Office. Items included in the per-term range amounts are room, deposit, wireless internet, air conditioning, etc. Campus housing costs, as set by the University Housing office, are as follows: Single: \$5,069.00, Double: \$4,656.00.

**What fees may a member encounter that are separate from dues billed by your chapter:**

Gamma Phi Beta members typically spend around \$100-150 on big-little clue week. While apparel is optional, members can buy apparel amounting to \$60 per semester. Members may choose to buy new outfits for date parties/formal/mixers which can amount to \$100 per semester. Depending on recruitment dress code, members may need to buy new clothes also amounting to \$100 if needed. There are no Fees for missing events, but they will be made up in alternative ways, such as assisting with set up or clean up at other events or participating in other committees. If your dues payment is late, you will be issued a 3% late Fee every month that the payment remains unpaid.
