

EPC-Recommended COLL 200 Language for Syllabi

COLL 200 courses encourage you to make coherent and meaningful interconnections across academic disciplines and recognize the difference in methodologies, modes of inquiry, and ways of knowing. They are "anchored" in at least one of the three knowledge domains: [Arts, Letters, and Values \(ALV\)](#); [Cultures, Societies, and the Individual \(CSI\)](#); and [Natural and Quantitative Reasoning \(NQR\)](#). These courses "reach out" to one or both of the other knowledge domains, highlighting commonalities and differences among disciplines.

This class is anchored in [ALV, CSI, NQR] and reaches out to [ALV, CSI, NQR]. Among other course objectives, this course specifically will ask you to:

1. Master basic ideas and methods central to the primary knowledge domain(s).
2. Make coherent and meaningful interconnections across the academic domains.
