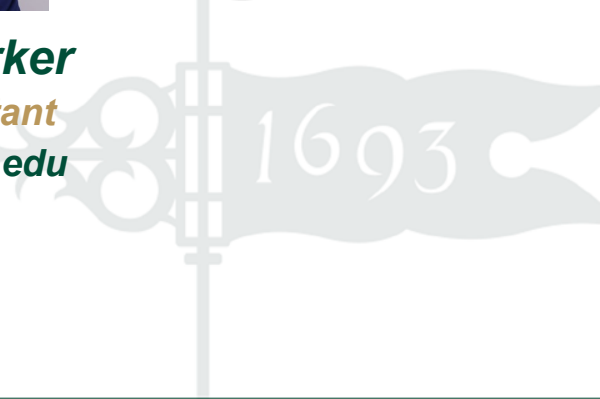

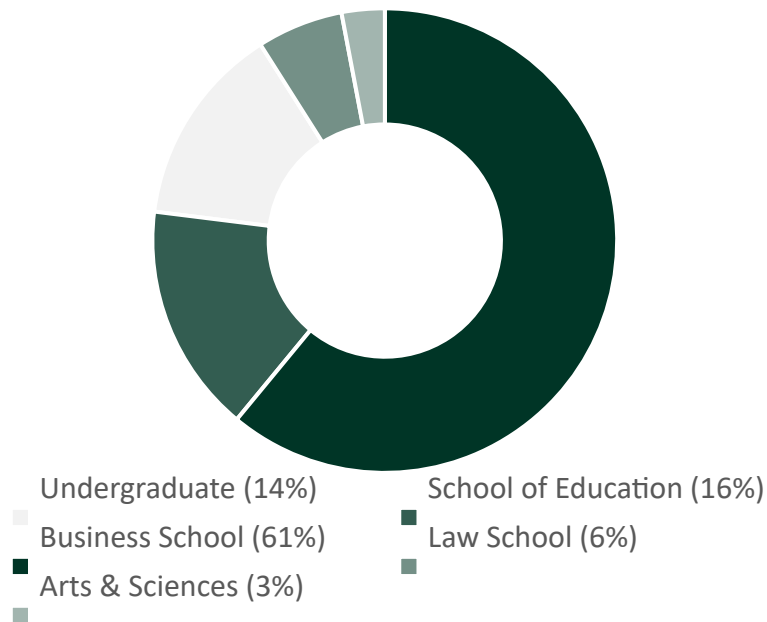
Academic Wellbeing offers a student-centered approach to provide students with opportunities to learn, lead, engage, and be bold and socially responsible.
