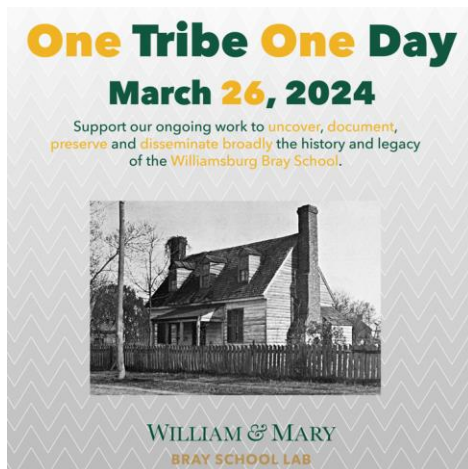

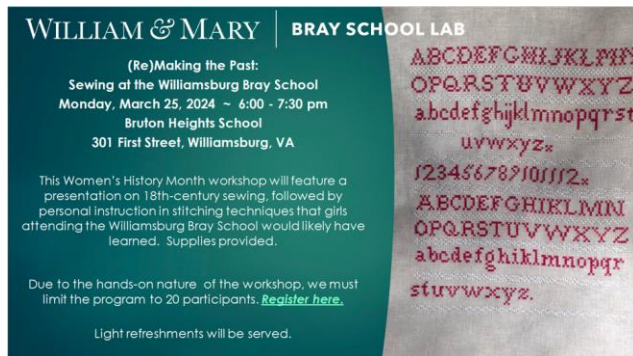

Descendants Week Coming April 15 – 20, 2024



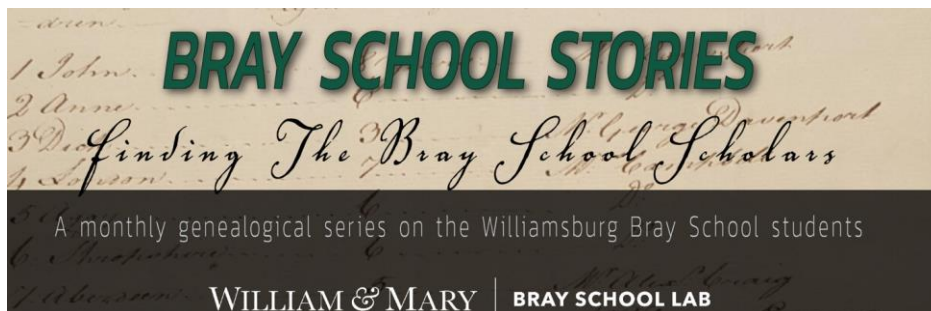
