- VI. Guest Speaker: Dan Pisaniello, Construction Project Updates
  - a. Upcoming year will be the "Year of the Environment"
  - b. Responsible for oversight of construction on campus and implementation of projects; guide the development of campus based on institutional priorities
  - c. This past September, university was at over 1 million square feet of certified green space. Big milestone!
  - Active projects: Muscarelle museum addition, School of Computing, Data Sciences and Physics (ISC4), Botetourt Theater (in Swem), Mackesey Sports Performance Center, Cedar Hall (Jamestown East), West 1 Housing & Dining (5 building complex where Yates Hall used to be; 4 residence halls and a dining facility), Old Dominion Hall renovation, Historic Campus restoration
