*To fund the purchase of a commemorative wreath for the 20th Anniversary of 9/11*

**The 9/11 Wreath Funding Act**

An Act of the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary.

Sponsored by Chair of the Senate Owen Williams ('23)

WHEREAS, it is an annual tradition at William & Mary that on the anniversary of the September 11th attacks, a wreath be placed on the pathway leading from the Wren Building to the Sunken Garden;

WHEREAS, though Student Assembly has always funded the purchase of this wreath, in past years it was financed through the Executive Appropriations Committee process via a Registered Student Organization who managed the placement and purchase of the wreath;

WHEREAS, the organization who handled the purchasing of the wreath, and also provided student volunteers to ceremonially guard the wreath, is not currently a recognised student organization;

WHEREAS, despite the change in oversight of the wreath, it is still an important tradition to respect, especially as we approach the 20th anniversary of the 9/11 attacks;

Now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Allocates \$200 from the Student Assembly Reserves to be allocated for the purchase of a commemorative wreath to demonstrate SA's continued commitment to recognizing the anniversary of the September 11th attacks.
2. Stipulates that any and all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
