

To support W&M student participation in the Muscarelle Museum of Art Driveway Chalk Art Competition

The Chalk Art Competition Act

An Act of the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary,

WHEREAS, the Muscarelle Museum of Art is hosting its first annual national Driveway Chalk Art competition, virtually, from May 31st, 2021 to September 6th, 2021;

WHEREAS, Student Assembly (SA), William & Mary's Office of Student Leadership Development (SLD), Student Transition Engagement Programs (STEP), and Muscarelle Museum of Art are partnering together to host an in-person Chalk Art event at the Crim Dell Corridor on September 4th, 2021 for students to enroll and then participate in the national challenge;

WHEREAS, following the Chalk Art event, there will be an "Art Walk" from 5:30 - 7 P.M. on September 5th, 2021 for students to view one another's pieces;

WHEREAS, the university designates open events as part of "My First W&M Weekend" in order to support new students finding activities and connections after orientation is completed. This event is well positioned as part of My First W&M Weekend to provide a social outlet for student organizations, halls, and groups of friends to participate together;

WHEREAS, having water for the Chalk Art event and then water and lemonade for the "Art Walk" would further incentivize students to participate in this community building event as well as keep students hydrated while outside;

WHEREAS, SLD, STEP, and the Muscarelle Museum of Art are co-sponsors of the event and will thus contribute partial funding for the event (covering chalk art supplies and the \$20/team registration fee);

WHEREAS, Student Assembly is also a sponsor of the event and therefore should also provide financial support;

WHEREAS, this will be a community building event and increase awareness of the Muscarelle Museum of Art.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Approves the allocation of up to \$950 from the Student Assembly Reserves to fund this initiative:
 - a. \$750 for two separate catering charges; the water station during the Chalk Art event (12:00-4:30 P.M.) and for the water and lemonade station during the “Art Walk” (5:30-7:00 P.M.)
 - b. \$200 for Facilities Management Charges for Trash Cans, tables, and chair rental
2. Stipulates that any funds not used will be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
