The Loco for Hoco 2021 Act

An Act of the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Chair of the Senate Owen Williams ('23)

Supported by Student Assembly Chief of Staff John Cho ('23)

WHEREAS, it is a tradition of the Student Assembly to sell Homecoming Shirts;

WHEREAS, conducting fundraising is the only way for Student Assembly to replenish its Off Campus Account, which supports vital internal operations;

WHEREAS, Homecoming is a long-standing tradition at William & Mary in which alumni and students come together to celebrate the school and their time at the College;

WHEREAS, Homecoming is also a time for students to unite and promote a sense of community within the William & Mary community;

WHEREAS, Homecoming was not able to be celebrated on a large scale, in-person in 2020 due to COVID-19 and shirts were not made for students;

WHEREAS, as student life has returned to campus, it is important that we bring back this important tradition of Student Assembly.

Now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary,

- 1. Allocates up to \$3000 from the Student Assembly Reserves for the purchasing of homecoming shirts.
- 2. Charges the Deputy Secretaries of Outreach with the advertisement of the selling (including pre-sale reservations) of the t-shirts, and members of the Executive Branch and all Senators with assisting in the selling of these shirts in the Sadler Atrium.
- 3. Stipulates that all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves and that revenue from t-shirt sales be deposited into the SA Off Campus Account.
