### **The Loco for Hoco 2021 Act**

An Act of the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary,

WHEREAS, it is a tradition of the Student Assembly to sell Homecoming Shirts;

WHEREAS, conducting fundraising is the only way for Student Assembly to replenish its Off Campus Account, which supports vital internal operations;

WHEREAS, Homecoming is a long-standing tradition at William & Mary in which alumni and students come together to celebrate the school and their time at the College;

WHEREAS, Homecoming is also a time for students to unite and promote a sense of community within the William & Mary community;

WHEREAS, Homecoming was not able to be celebrated on a large scale, in-person in 2020 due to COVID-19 and shirts were not made for students;

WHEREAS, as student life has returned to campus, it is important that we bring back this important tradition of Student Assembly.

Now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary,

1. Allocates up to \$3000 from the Student Assembly Reserves for the purchasing of homecoming shirts.
2. Charges the Deputy Secretaries of Outreach with the advertisement of the selling (including pre-sale reservations) of the t-shirts, and members of the Executive Branch and all Senators with assisting in the selling of these shirts in the Sadler Atrium.
3. Stipulates that all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves and that revenue from t-shirt sales be deposited into the SA Off Campus Account.
