## A Bill

To provide funding for research, travel, and workshop purposes of Student Assembly committees

## The Plan Committees Funding Act

An Act of the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Senator Taylor Fox ('24)

Supported by Student Assembly President Meghana Boojala ('22)

WHEREAS, the committees underneath The Plan are undertaking the large responsibility of extensively and deliberately researching systems of racial injustice at the College to collectively improve the student experience;

WHEREAS, these students are unpaid and are volunteering their valuable time and energy towards collecting, synthesizing, and publicizing information;

WHEREAS, monetary aid towards furthering their research and helping them access the resources they need would allow them greater flexibility in their work;

WHEREAS, the committees shall use allocated money to fund research, travel, workshops, and any other activities required for them to fulfill their duties;

WHEREAS, this funding will help sustain The Plan as students conduct research for Student Assembly initiatives.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary:

- 1. Allocate \$3,000 dollars from the Student Assembly Reserves to be utilized for research and training purposes for the committees underneath The Plan: The Reparations Committee, The Academic Diversity Project, The Student's Rights Initiative, The Committee for the Contextualization of Campus Landmarks & Iconography, and The Student Community Policing Advisory Board.
- 2. The funds shall be used for funding travel by road to regional locations for research purposes, training workshops, and meals for traveling.
- 3. Stipulates that all unused funds remain in the Student Assembly Reserves.
