To provide funding for colored flyers and a tabling event for the promotion of flu shots

The Adieu to the Flu (Pandemic Version) Act

An Act of the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Senator Sailor Miao ('24) and Senator Eugene Lee ('23)

Co-Sponsored by Senator Vicky Morales ('22)

Supported by Secretary of Health and Safety Amelia Grossman ('22)

WHEREAS, the Student Health Center offers a variety of services that many members of the student body are not aware of;

WHEREAS, the Student Health Center is offering free flu vaccinations to the students who have the school insurance while the school provides 4 free vaccination clinics at Kaplan for those that do not have school insurance;

WHEREAS, one of these vital services is the provision of free flu vaccinations for students on campus;

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention recommends those ages 6 months and older receive a flu shot in order to lessen the impact of flu season;

WHEREAS, influenza activity often increases in October, peaking in February, and can last as late as May;

WHEREAS, the general population has isolated at home since the beginning of the pandemic thus rendered them more vulnerable for the flu season;

WHEREAS, the 327th Student Assembly has previously supported the efforts for the advertisement and promotion of free flu shots at the Campus Health Center;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Allocates \$45 for the printing of colored flyers near Sadler Terrace advertising the Student Health Center's availability of free flu shots for students who have UHCSR insurance and the flu shot clinics for students without UHCSR insurance at Kaplan on October 25 and November 1 from 9am to 3pm.

- 2. Charges the Outreach Department to design the flyers, posters for A-frames in SA possession, and social media graphics for the advertisement and promotion of flu shot availability.
- 3. Charges the Secretary of Health and Safety, the Secretary of Outreach and the sponsors of this bill with the advertisement of these offerings by posting flyers across campus, (including graduate schools), and placing the A-frame posters in front of Sadler Center and Campus Center.
- 4. Encourages members of the Student Assembly to actively promote and educate the student body of free flu vaccination availability at the Student Health Center, and to share all related online graphics via members' social media accounts.
- 5. Stipulates all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
