To promote giving winter clothing to the homeless community in Williamsburg

The Winter Clothing Drive Act

An Act of the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Senator Shaunna Scott ('23)

Supported by Senator Taylor Fox ('24), Senator Maheen Saeed ('23)

WHEREAS, homelessness is an ongoing issue in Williamsburg;

WHEREAS, it is starting to get cold outside and necessary for warmer clothing;

WHEREAS, having a winter clothing drive would bring awareness to the issue of homelessness and benefit the less fortunate;

WHEREAS, House of Mercy, a nonprofit organization in Williamsburg, is willing to accept all donations if they are cleaned beforehand;

WHEREAS, if House of Mercy is unable to accept all of the donations due to lack of space, the remaining clothing will be donated to The Trans Locker;

WHEREAS, the Center for Student Diversity is willing to give any necessary funds to make sure all the clothing is washed;

WHEREAS, Student Union Engagement's is willing to give space in Sadler Center and Campus Center during November 29th-December 13th to set up donation boxes;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary,

- 1. Request Class Presidents to send emails about this event in order to gain more awareness from the students.
- 2. Encourage Senators and Class Presidents to repost flyers on instagram and promote in group chats
- 3. Require Outreach Department to share the information on a regular basis during the drive
- 4. Allocates \$7 from the Student Assembly Reserves for flyers
- 5. Stipulates that all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
