A Bill

To promote the new Campus Recreation rental process of fifteen double hammocks

The Rent A Hammock Act

An Act of the 329th Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Senator Sean Nguyen ('25) and Senator Hashir Aqeel ('25)

Supported by Linda Knight (Campus Recreation Director), Michael White (Outdoor Recreation Assistant Director), and James Holmes (Assistant Director - Facilities & Equipment)

WHEREAS, hammocks are currently not available for student checkout at the Campus Recreation;

WHEREAS, there is heightened interest among the student body to be able to rent out hammocks for student usage;

WHEREAS, gentle rocking and swaying in hammocks strengthens mental health by allowing individuals to fall asleep faster, diminish high-stress hormone levels, and remedy panic attacks & anxiety;

WHEREAS, the Sponsors of the Bill collaborated with Campus Recreation to purchase fifteen double hammocks of a variety of colors and the hanging hardware pricing to \$407.25;

WHEREAS, Campus Recreation seeks the sponsorship of Student Assembly in the advertisement of the double hammocks rental;

WHEREAS, the hammocks will be <u>rented</u> alongside other "Camping and Outdoor Equipment Rental" to be able to replace poor-quality ones and ensure the hammock rental's continuity;

WHEREAS, the Campus Recreation will be providing monthly data on the rental rate of the hammocks to the Sponsors of the Bill to evaluate if more will need to be purchased;

WHEREAS, the hammocks will be available for check-out on Friday, February 11, 2022, for students to begin renting.

Now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary,

- 1. Request Class Presidents to send emails about the new rental availability in order to gain more awareness from the students.
- 2. Charge the sponsors of the bill to create a <u>flyer</u> that can be printed and posted on social media, and to post flyers across campus.

- 3. Encourage Senators and Class Presidents to repost flyers on Instagram and promote them in group chats.
- 4. Require Outreach Department to share the information on a regular basis.
- 5. Allocates \$7 from the Student Assembly Reserves for flyers.
- 6. Stipulates that all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
