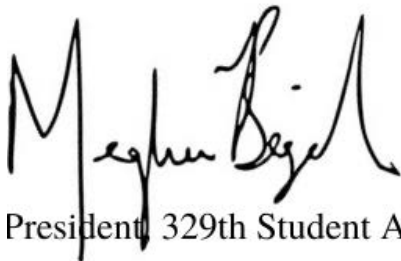

**The Movie Under the Stars Act**

WHEREAS, this event will foster relationships and lasting bonds between students. Where students have been asking for events that will allow them to have interactions with others given the COVID Pandemic has limited this experience for William & Mary students;

WHEREAS, this event will happen on Sunken Gardens on a warm night during the Spring semester of 2022;

WHEREAS, popcorn is an integral part of the movie-watching experience. Moreover, it is vegan and gluten-free which is inclusive to students with dietary restrictions. We also will provide cotton candy as it is a favorite of students;

WHEREAS, a poll will be created with movie choices and be sent out to the entire student body to ask them what movie option they would like to spectate;

WHEREAS, this is a great student activity for students utilizing student activity funds as many William & Mary students expressed they would like. It also allows students to be socially distanced and unmasked outside, which gives them a break from the constant mask-wearing.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Charges the sponsors of the bill with executing and planning this event and other action items.
2. Charges the Department of Outreach with promoting the event on Student Assembly social media accounts, and creating a flyer that can be posted on social media.
3. Charges all students assembly members with the promotion of the event, whether that be through hanging posters or posting continuously on social media about the sponsored event utilizing the online posters created by the Department of Outreach.
4. Allocates \$4,500 from Student Assembly reserves
  - a. Movie Licensing: \$300-\$2000
  - b. Inflatable Movie Screen/Outdoor Projector and Speakers: \$2,000
  - c. Popcorn: \$60
  - d. Popcorn Flavoring: \$50

- e. Containers for popcorn: \$16.00
  - f. Cotton Candy Supplies \$60.00
    - i. Cotton Candy Flavored Sugar
    - ii. Cotton Candy Paper Sticks
5. Stipulates that all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
