## A Bill

To support W&M student participation in the Muscarelle Museum of Art Chalk Art Competition

## The Chalk Art Competition Act Part 2

An Act of the 330th Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Class President Mia Tilman ('24), Senator Gloriana Cubero Fernandez ('24), Senator Regina Chaillo ('25)

Supported by Senior Advisor for Community Engagement and Outreach Taylor Fox ('24)

WHEREAS, the Muscarelle Museum of Art is hosting its second annual national Chalk Art competition in late summer 2022 with the intended return of a W&M recognition/event during the national competition.

WHEREAS, Student Assembly (SA), William & Mary's Office of Student Leadership Development (SLD), Student Transition Engagement Programs (STEP), and Muscarelle Museum of Art are partnering together to host the W&M Chalk Art event at the Crim Dell Corridor on September 3rd, 2022 as part of the national challenge;

WHEREAS, following the Chalk Art event, there will be promoted "Art Walk" for students and community members to view the submissions;

WHEREAS, the university designates open events as part of "My First W&M Weekend" in order to support new students finding activities and connections after orientation is completed. This event is well positioned as part of My First W&M Weekend to provide a social outlet for student organizations, halls, and groups of friends to participate together;

WHEREAS, having water for the Chalk Art event and then water and lemonade for the "Art Walk" would further incentivize students to participate in this community building event as well as keep students hydrated while outside;

WHEREAS, sponsors are able to build on the success of last year and add enhancements to the events that will support the festivities such as a DJ for music and ability to make announcements for all participants and upgrade the social aspect of the Chalk Art competition.

WHEREAS, SLD, STEP, and the Muscarelle Museum of Art are co-sponsors of the event and will thus contribute partial funding for the event (covering chalk art supplies and the \$20/team registration fee);

WHEREAS, Student Assembly is also a sponsor of the event and therefore should also provide financial support;

WHEREAS, this will be a community building event and increase awareness of the Muscarelle Museum of Art.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

- 1. Approves the allocation of up to \$1600 from the Student Assembly Reserves to fund this initiative:
  - a. \$850 for beverage stations during the competition and art walk.
  - b. \$200 for Facilities Management Charges for Trash Cans, Tables, and Chair Rental
  - c. \$450 for a 4 hour DJ contract
- 2. Stipulates that any funds not used will be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
