A BILL

To help RSOs advertise during the Student Organization & Activities Fair,

The Poster Party Part III Act

An Act of the 332nd Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Class President Zoe Wang ('26), Class President Nico Giro-Martin ('27)

Cosponsored by Senator Matt Swenson ('26)

WHEREAS, multiple RSOs requested funding for tri-folds and other tabling/marketing supplies, to be used during the Student Organization & Activities Fair, in all quarters last OBAC fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the "Trifold Making Party" streamlines the use of the Student Activities Fee funds by making the same supplies that are requested by multiple organizations available to those organizations; and

WHEREAS, this event will continue to support RSOs in increasing engagement and promoting themselves to students, especially incoming/freshman students;

WHEREAS, the first, second, and third iterations of the "Trifold Making Party" were held before the Fall and Spring Student Organization & Activities Fair and DFAS. All these events were incredibly successful;

WHEREAS, this bill would fund iterations of the "Trifold Making Party" next academic year. This year each organization will only be allowed to receive one trifold;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

- 1. Allocates up to \$1000 from Student Assembly Reserves for;
 - a. Tri-fold posters
 - b. Glue, scissors, pre-adhesive letters if supplies need to be replenished
- 2. Charges the sponsors of the bill with executing and planning the event;
- 3. Charges the Secretary of Finance, Class Presidents, and the Department of Outreach with advertising the event;
- 4. Stipulates that all unused funds will return to the Student Assembly reserves.
